

Common mistakes when renting a stump grinder

- Fully read manual before operating or calling.
- Unit is full of gas upon renting, you can either return full or we charge by the gallon.
- The stump grinder has carbide tipped teeth on the grinding wheel, we verify them before leaving and again upon returning, if any of them are broken, missing or chipped beyond the point of re-dressing there will be a replacement charge per tooth. Rocks are the biggest reason the teeth get damaged.
- If the stump is rotten and extremely soft, be careful that the stump grinder is not taking such a large bite of the wood as this may damage belt. Also, downward pressure onto the head will do the same.
- There are a total of three on and off switches on the unit. One on the front of the engine, one on the center of the handlebar, and the rocker arm on the end of the handle bar is connected to a switch.
