

## Care for Hot Water Pressure Washer

- Fully read operator's manual before operating.
- Fully read instructions as you are responsible for any repairs/parts needed and all lost rentals.
- Adhere to all safety decals on machine when operating.
- Pressure washer must be transported in the back of a van only when temperatures are below freezing.
- If ramps are needed for loading and unloading we will be happy to provide these at no additional cost. Please ask.
- Make sure garden hose that is being used is fully empty of ice and debris (run water through it) before pulling pressure washer and pressure hose out of van.
- Do not run pressure washer dry.
- Do not let pressure washer run/idle while not running water through pressure hose for more than 30 seconds.
- Do not let pressure washer and hoses sit outside if you go in for lunch or to make an errand.
- If keeping overnight make sure to bring pressure washer and hoses into a heated area.
- If using jetter hose maximum temperature of 150 degrees!
- When shutting the pressure washer down, turn burner off and run water through the hose until cold water is coming out.
- Both the gas and the kerosene are full upon pick-up. Can be returned full otherwise we charge by the gallon.
